Every place has its own unique personality and character and to compare them would somehow dishonour each one.

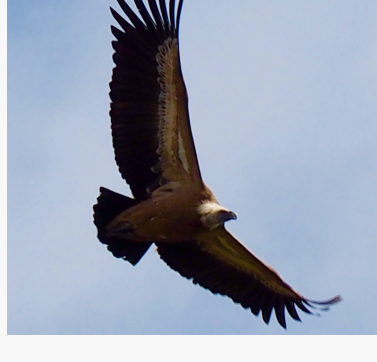
So we have collected some special memories that we will share from each country and whilst some may feel more memorable than another, in truth, every place has touched our hearts.

And the best place for a fiesta has to be Spain, especially between February and April!



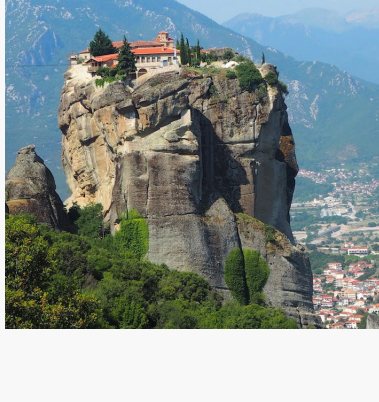
The wildlife we've seen along the way has blown our minds. Vultures, Flamingoes, Pelicans, Bee Eaters, Spoonbills.

Churches and Monasteries are iconic across Europe.

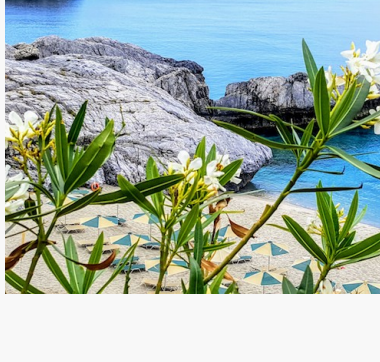
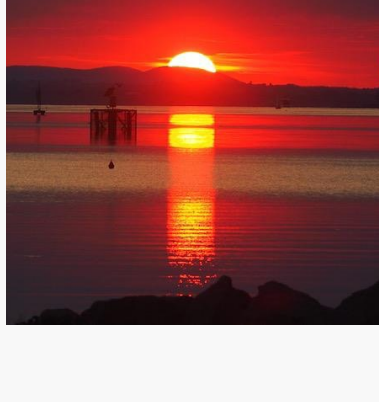
France has its chateaux, Spain its cathedrals, Italy its churches and Greece?

Well Greece has Meteora.



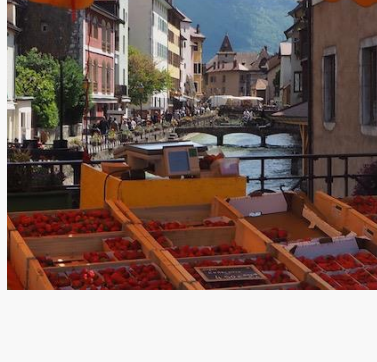
And the sunrises and sunsets have just taken our breath away.

They look like something out of a holiday brochure.

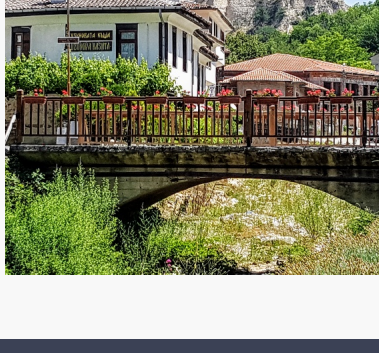


We have always loved the weekly markets as this is where authentic life and culture come alive.

France and Spain seriously know how to do markets.

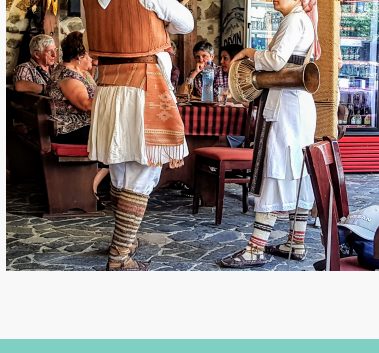
Architectural brilliance comes in many forms; natural landscapes and building structures.

Each country's traditions are either subtly woven into their culture or obviously written into their values.

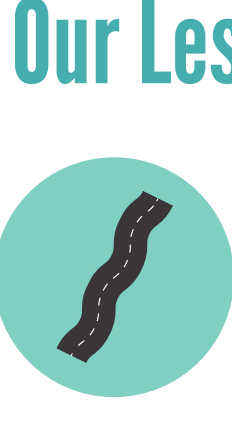
Seeing traditional music and costume in Bulgaria was so endearing.



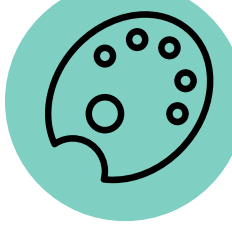
## Our Camping Highlights

We have come up with our Top 10 Camping Highlights across our 18 month trip, which we will share with you to inspire your next trip.



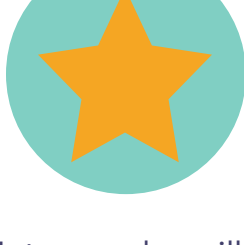
Travel is an inner journey as much as the miles you cover.

Standing still is the new form of movement.



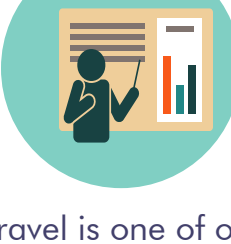
Staying in the present moment and enjoying NOW is key to enriching experiences.
